If you want to go up and clean panels but you're concerned about roof safety, then fit an eyebolt on the opposite wall to your solar panels, near the bottom (in the mortar would be fine). Attach one end of a long rope to the eye bolt, then hurl rest of it over the rooftop to the other side and use rappelling gear. Clean panels are a good thing.

Spray the panels with a hose. Knock off any loose dirt and debris, then use a garden hose with a spray attachment to rinse the solar panels and surrounding roof. This will loosen the grime and make it easier to scrub the panels clean. If you have to climb to the roof for this, make sure someone is holding the ladder steady.
