Will oil projects boost Iraq's oil and gas reserves?

Iraq's Oil Minister Hayan Abdel Ghani said the offered projects will boost the country's oil and gas reserves. Reuters Iraq Prime Minister Mohammed Shia Al Sudani said his country is committed to "assuring a safe and stable working environment" and to remove "complicated routine and bureaucracy".

Will Iraq launch a sixth bidding round to auction off gas blocks?

Iraq's oil ministry has ended preparation to launch a sixth bidding round to auction off the gas blocks, the ministry said, without setting a date for the bidding process.

Will Iraq launch a new gas investment project?

Abdel-Ghani also said Iraq will launch a new gas investment project by the end of the yearat the Al-Faihaa oil field in southern Iraq. The project, with a capacity of 125 million standard cubic feet (mscf), is a key component of Iraq's strategy to enhance its energy infrastructure.

The latest initiative follows recent agreements to develop 13 oil and gas blocks, aimed at increasing Iraq's crude and gas output to supply power plants, which currently rely heavily on Iranian gas imports. In Iraq"s recent energy bidding round, Chinese companies secured most of the oil and gas contracts. The bidding round, which commenced on Saturday, offers a total of 29 projects spanning three days.
