For every 1,000 kWh generated from your solar installation over 15 years, you earn one SREC-II. These can be sold to utility companies for a set price of \$85.

The solar sales tax exemption ensures that you won't have to pay a sales tax on your system,while the solar property tax exemption means you don't need to pay a higher property tax for adding solar panels to your house.

In addition to the state tax exemptions and solar tax credits offered by the state of New Jersey, you can also benefit from a federal tax incentive known as the Residential clean energy credit. This is a tax incentive that New Jersey residents who own homes with installed solar energy equipment can claim on their US federal income taxes.
