Some old, broken tools may still have life in them, you just have to get a little creative. For example, if you have a reciprocating saw that no longer works, take the blade and turn it ...

Don't worry, though. You can easily fix a Ryobi battery that is in sleep mode by giving it tiny charge boosts. When you connect it to a power source, there's 2-3 seconds of charging before it says "stop, I'm asleep!". Those couple of seconds are how we bring it back to life.

Alkaline batteries such as D, C, AA, AAA and 9-volt can be disposed of in your regular trash. Make sure to prevent any fire risk by taping 9-volt terminals before tossing. NiCd batteries containing lead must be properly recycled to prevent environmental hazards. Consider bringing old batteries to a local battery recycling drop-off.

If your Ryobi battery is dead, check the charging temperature, clean the terminals, and check if it's in sleep mode. If so, use "mini-charges" - slot the battery into the charger for a few secs, remove before the lights flash. Repeat up to 30 min until it has enough charge to "revive" itself.
