AFREC"s energy balance 2020 show that thetotal primary energy supply was 170 ktoe. Biomass (firewood and charcoal) is used heavily for cooking purposes. There is no oil refinery. As a result, all petroleum products including jet fuel, gasoline and kerosene have to be imported. The fuel comes mostly from an Angolan supplier that has an effective monopoly.

Kosmos Energy has taken two more blocks in São Tomé and Príncipe"s Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ), in a farm-in agreement with Equator Exploration.
