All solar panel strings connected in parallel have to feature the same voltage, and they also have to comply with the NEC 690.7, NEC 690.8(A)(1), and NEC 690.8(A)(2). Modules need to be the same model in all cases in order to provide optimum performance on the system.

The most common solar panel sizes for residential installations are between 250W and 400W, while larger commercial installations may use panels up to 500W or more. ... According to a National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL) study, premium modern solar panel manufacturers such as Panasonic and LG offer panels with degradation rates as low as 0.30% per year. The worst degradation rate is .80% a year, but as a benchmark, you can expect an average degradation rate of .50% a year for any panel.

To be more accurate, a typical open circuit voltage of a solar cell is 0.58 volts (at 77°F or 25°C). All the PV cells in all solar panels have the same 0.58V voltage. Because we connect them in series, the total output voltage is the sum of the voltages of individual PV cells. ... 36-Cell Solar Panel Output Voltage = $36 \times 0.58V = 20.88V$...

If the sun shines on a solar panel with a 20% efficiency rating, 20% of the sun's energy will convert to solar energy in ideal conditions. Given the same amount of sunlight shining simultaneously on two equal-sized solar panels with different efficiency ratings, the more efficient panel will produce more power than the less efficient panel.
